# JACKSON COUNTY PARKS MILLAGE PROPOSAL

For the purpose of funding capital improvements, maintenance, restoration, renovation and operations of Jackson County Parks, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Jackson, Michigan, be increased, and shall the County be authorized to levy, up to 0.50 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of ten (10) years, 2018 through 2027, inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$2,180,000 for providing funds for County Parks purposes in the first calendar year of the levy based on taxable value. If approved and levied, in accordance with State law a portion of the millage may be distributed to the Downtown Development Authorities, the Local Development Finance Authorities, and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities in Jackson County.

# JACKSON COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL AND SHELTER MILLAGE PROPOSAL

For the purpose of funding capital improvements, the personnel and operations of Jackson County Animal Control and Animal Shelter, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Jackson, Michigan, be increased, and shall the County be authorized to levy, up to 0.25 mill (\$0.25 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of ten (10) years, 2018 through 2027, inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$1,090,000 for providing funds for Animal Control and Animal Shelter purposes in the first calendar year of the levy based on taxable value. If approved and levied, in accordance with State law a portion of the millage may be distributed to the Downtown Development Authorities, the Local Development Finance Authorities, and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities in Jackson County.

## **ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL**

### **ROAD MILLAGE INCREASE**

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Concord Township of one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.9370 mills (\$0.93 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased and levied at two and one half (2.5) mills (\$2.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for fifteen (15) years, 2018 through 2032 inclusive, for the purpose of continuing to provide funds for the repair, improvement and maintenance of roads within the Township, which will raise an estimated \$202,724.10 in 2018?

# SANDSTONE CHARTER TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZATION OF RENEWAL OF MILLAGE FOR POLICE PROTECTION AND PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation, imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in Charter Township of Sandstone of 0.5 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which is set to expire on December 31, 2017, be renewed at the same rate of 0.50 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for five (5) years, 2018 through 2022 inclusive, to be used to provide police protection and public safety services for the residents of Sandstone Charter Township, whether by contracting for such services or establishing a police department. This millage will raise an estimated Seventy Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$70,500) in the first year the millage is levied.

# I. LITCHFIELD COMMUNITY SCHOOLS OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18.4 mills (\$18.40 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Litchfield Community Schools, Hillsdale, Jackson, Calhoun and Branch Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 4 years, 2019 to 2022, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2019 is approximately \$430,130 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy)?

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the building and site sinking fund millage that expires with the 2018 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate of .75 mill (\$0.75 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in Litchfield Community Schools, Hillsdale, Jackson, Calhoun and Branch Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 4 years, 2019 to 2022, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2019 is approximately \$70,600 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy)?

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Litchfield Community Schools, Hillsdale, Jackson, Calhoun and Branch Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed .5 mill (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 4 years, 2018 to 2021, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for school security improvements, the acquisition or upgrading of technology, the purchase of real estate sites for school buildings, and the construction or repair of school buildings, and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2018 is approximately \$47,100?

# MARSHALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Marshall Public Schools, Calhoun and Jackson Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2019 to 2028, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2019 is approximately \$4,120,827 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy)?

# MICHIGAN CENTER SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Michigan Center School District, Jackson County, Michigan, be renewed by 18.9373 mills (\$18.9373 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2019 to 2024, inclusive, and also be increased by 0.0627 mill (\$0.0627 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2019 to 2024, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2019 is approximately \$1,008,474 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 levy and a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?

# NORTHWEST COMMUNITY SCHOOLS BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Northwest Community Schools, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-Four Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$24,965,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings; partially remodeling, furnishing and refurnishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; acquiring, installing and equipping school buildings with instructional technology; remodeling, improving and equipping the high school athletic complex; and preparing, developing, improving and equipping athletic fields, athletic facilities and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2018 is .92 mills (\$.92 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-five (25) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 1.95 mills (\$1.95 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

# STOCKBRIDGE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance. The remaining 5.2595 mills are only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Stockbridge Community Schools, Ingham, Jackson, Livingston and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 23.2595 mills (\$23.2595 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2019 to 2024, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2019 is approximately \$4,909,310 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy)?
