REASONS FOR DEMANDING THE RECALL OF ADAM G. ULBIN

Shall Adam Ulbin be recalled from the office of Township Supervisor for Norvell Township for the following reasons:

- 1) Supervisor Ulbin has failed to provide effective administrative oversight and monitoring of township revenue, there by leading to major accounting discrepancies in township financial records, there fore the township has not passed the last three financial audits which has happened over the last four to six years.
- 2) Supervisor Ulbin stated in his letter to the editor of the Brooklyn Exponent, dated July 24th, 2007 "apparently the petitioners are not aware that duties and responsibilities delegated by state statute to a particular elected officer can not be taken away from that officer and given or taken over, by someone else. Independently elected officials are not employees. In other words, the supervisor can no more assume or interfere with the functions of the clerk or treasurer then the clerk or treasurer can assume the duties and responsibilities of the supervisor or any other statutory official. Each officer has independent functions and duties". Supervisor Ulbin does have the authority to make public incompetence of another elected official so as to allow the voters of the township to take action. (i.e. recall). Or he can go to the state authorities and ask them to remove that official.

JUSTIFICATION OF CONDUCT IN OFFICE BY ADAM G. ULBIN

This recall petition would have you believe that the former Norvell Township Treasurer was a hired employee of my office. This is not true. The fact is, each Township Official has specific statutory duties and responsibilities, and is independently elected.

After the Treasurers' resignation in January 2007, two staff members who worked with the former Treasurer, became aware of sewer district accounting irregularities. This was brought to the attention of the Township Board, we acted swiftly and responsibly to address this issue.

The Township's Auditors who consulted with the former Treasurer, did not recognize the nature, or extent of the Sewer Districts accounting issues, and consequently the Township Board had not been apprised of this situation by the auditors. By board action an independent CPA, Forensic Accountant was hired. He has reconciled both Sewer District accounts. A claim has been filed with the Township's Bonding Company to recover sewer funds believed to be relevant to this matter.

I have served Norvell Township for a number of years, and I am committed to keeping the public trust, and pledge this commitment.
