MILLAGE PROPOSAL

BUILDING AND SITE
SINKING FUND TAX LEVY

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Hanover-Horton School District, Jackson and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2007 to 2011, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2007 is approximately \$231,736?

**LESLIE PUBLIC SCHOOLS
OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This proposal will enable the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property except principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property as defined by law, in Leslie Public Schools, Ingham and Jackson Counties, Michigan, be increased by 2 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of 4 years, 2007 to 2010, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2007 is approximately \$70,804 (this millage is to restore millage loss as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore that reduction)?

PROPOSITION A
OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL
NON-PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE AND NON-QUALIFIED
AGRICULTURAL PROPERTY TAX

(Passage of this millage proposal will allow the School District to levy not more than the statutory rate of 18 mills against non-principal residence and non-qualified agricultural property required for the School District to receive its revenue per-pupil foundation guarantee).

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, excepting principal residence and qualified agricultural property, in Springport Public Schools, Calhoun, Eaton, Ingham and Jackson Counties, Michigan, be increased by 2.0 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of five years, 2007 through 2011, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes, such increase being a renewal of 1.9230 mills which expired with the 2006 levy and the authorization of 0.077 new additional mills (the estimated amount of revenue that will be collected in calendar year 2007 if said 2.0 mills is authorized and levied is \$55,547 all of which will be disbursed to Springport Public Schools).
