STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statement of votes cast in the one voting precinct [and in the Absent Voter's Counting Board] of the COLUMBIA SCHOOL DISTRICT at the Special Election held on Tuesday, April 20, 1993, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk and with this Board. Having examined and considered said statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for and against the proposition, reading:

A. MILLAGE PROPOSITION FOR OPERATION

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in COLUMBIA SCHOOL DISTRICT, Jackson, Hillsdale, Washtenaw and Lenawee Counties, Michigan, be increased by 26.6 mills (\$26.60 on each \$1,000) on state equalized valuation for a period of one year, 1993, and the school district's maximum authorized allocated millage rate be approved for levy in 1993, without the reduction required by Section 31 of Article IX of the State Constitution of 1963 to provide additional funds for operating purposes (this being, in part, a renewal of 26.6 mills for operating purposes which expired with the 1992 tax levy)? If approved, the said 26.6 mills will be levied against the final state equalized valuation for 1993 and will not be subject to the millage reduction required under Section 31 of Article IX of the State Constitution of 1963 for 1993.
