STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the one (1) voting precinct of
the District, (and in the Absent voter's County Board) of the
Michigan Center School at the Special Election held on Monday,
October 18, 1993, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk,
and with this Board. Having examined and considered said
statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for and
against the two propositions, reading:

MILLAGE PROPOSITION FOR OPERATION

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be
assessed against all property in Michigan Center School District,
Jackson county, Michigan, be increased by 3.2 mills (\$3.20 on
\$1,000) on state equalized valuation for one (1) year, 1993 for
the purpose of providing additional funds for operating purposes?
(The revenue increase in 1993 to be realized if the 3.2 mills is
approved and levied will be approximately \$291,785.00).

MILLAGE PROPOSITION FOR BUSSING, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, TEXTBOOKS
AND PROGRAM

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed
against all property in Michigan Center School District, Jackson
County, Michigan, be increased by 1.95 mills (\$1.95 on each

\$1,000) on state equalized valuation for one (1) year, 1993, for the purpose of providing additional funds for operating purposes to be used: to restore a full bussing program, and for expansion of computer science equipment and applications and purchase textbooks. (The revenue increase in 1993 to be realized from the 1.95 mills, if approved and levied, will be approximately \$177,806.00.)
