for the following proposition:

PROPOSAL A
POLICE MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previous voted increase in the 15 mill tax limitation and levy be
increased by one (1) mill (1\$ on each \$1,000 of State Equalized Valuation) upon taxable
real and tangible personal property within the Township of Columbia, Jackson County,
Michigan be renewed for levy in the years 1994 through 1998, inclusive, solely for the
purpose of the operation and maintenance of the Columbia Township Police
Department, which increase will raise in the first year of such levy an
estimated \$151,474?

Votes for One hundred and eighty six (186)
Votes against Two hundred and seventy five (275)
The ballot question has been determined to have failed.

PROPOSAL B FIRE MILLAGE

Shall the 15 mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within the Township
of Columbia, Jackson County, Michigan imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the
Michigan Constitution be increased for said Township by one-half (1/2) mill (\$.50 per
\$1,000 of State Equalized Valuation) for the five year period of 1994 through 1998,
inclusive, solely for the purpose of the operation and maintenance of the Columbia
Township Fire Department; and shall the Township levy such increase and millage for
such purpose during such period, which increase will raise in the first year of such
levy and estimated \$75,737?

Votes for Two hundred and sixty two (262)
Votes against One hundred and ninety seven (197)
The ballot question has been determined to have passed.
