STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the two (2) voting precinct's of the District, at the Special Election held on Monday, August 29, 1994, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk, and with this Board. Having examined and considered said statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for and against the one proposition, reading:

PROPOSAL (1)

BONDING PROPOSITION

Shall Columbia School District, Jackson, Lenawee, Washtenaw and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Seven Million Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$7,450,00) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

- a. erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to and partially remodeling and partially re-equipping the Brooklyn and Miller Elementary Schools and the Junior High School;
- b. partially remodeling and partially re-equipping the High School and the Clarklake School;
- c. purchasing and installing technology systems and equipment in school facilities;
- d. constructing and equipping outdoor athletic facilities and playgrounds and developing and improving sites?
