STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the one (1) voting precinct of the District, at a special election held on Monday, March 28, 1994, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered said statements, the whole number of votes given for and against the proposition reading as follows:

BONDING PROPOSITION

Shall Springport Public Schools, Jackson, Calhoun, Eaton and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Five Million Three Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,395,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of erecting, furnishing and equipping classroom additions to the Annex and remodeling and re-equipping the Annex for elementary school purposes; erecting, furnishing and equipping a gymnasium addition to the high school building; and developing and improving the site?
