APRIL 25, 1995

in Columbia School District, Jackson, Lenawee, Washtenaw and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan (the "District"), and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of Jackson County, Michigan.

STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the two (2) voting precincts of the District, at a special election held on Tuesday, April 25, 1995, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered said statements, the whole number of votes given for and against the proposition reading as follows:

I. BONDING PROPOSITION - MIDDLE SCHOOL

Shall Columbia School District, Jackson, Lenawee, Washtenaw and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,800,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

- erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to and partially remodeling and partially re-equipping the junior high school for middle school purposes; and developing and improving the site?

- erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to and partially remodeling and partially re-equipping the Brooklyn and Miller Elementary Schools; and developing and improving sites?

- acquiring, installing and equipping all school facilities for technology?
