Shall Hanover-Horton School District, Jackson and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Eight Million Seven Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$8,725,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

erecting and furnishing an addition to and partially remodeling the existing Hanover Elementary School;

erecting and furnishing additions to and partially remodeling the existing Central Complex Building for high school and junior high school purposes;

acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping the Hanover Elementary School and the Central Complex Building for administrative offices, adult education and Kids' Club (day care) purposes;

erecting and furnishing a new bus garage; constructing and equipping a new playground; and

developing and improving sites?
