STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the one (8) voting precincts of
the District, at the Special Election held on Saturday, April 13,
1996, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk, and with this
Board. Having examined and considered said statement, this Board
has canvassed the votes cast for and against the one proposition,
reading:

PROPOSAL (A)

NON-HOMESTEAD MILLAGE PROPOSITION FOR OPERATION

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed
against non-homestead property in Jackson Public Schools, Jackson
County, Michigan, be increased by eighteen (18) mills (\$18.00 on
each \$1,000) on taxable valuation for ten (10) years, 1996
through 2005, inclusive, to provide additional funds for
operating purposes?

(Passage of this proposition will enable the District to levy 18
mills on non-homestead property in 1997 and in years 2005,
subject to possible reduction pursuant to the Headlee Amendment,
Michigan State Constitution of 1963, as amended).

(If this proposal is approved, and the District levies 18 mills
on non-homestead property, as required by Michigan Public Act 312
of 1993, the revenue increase in 1996 to be realized from the
portion of such levy authorized by the passage of this proposal
will be approximately \$6,151,484)
