in East Jackson Community Schools, Jackson County, Michigan (the "District"), and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of Jackson County, Michigan.

STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the one (1) voting precinct of the District, at a special election held on Tuesday, February 20, 1996, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered said statements, the whole number of votes given for and against the proposition reading as follows:

BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall East Jackson Community Schools, Jackson County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Seven Million One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$7,130,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

- erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to the high school and elementary school buildings;
- partially remodeling and re-equipping all buildings;
- constructing a storage building and improving outdoor physical education facilities at the middle school site;
- developing and improving sites, including school playgrounds; and
- purchasing and installing educational technology equipment for all school facilities?
