**JANUARY 29, 1996**

in Northwest School District, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan (the "District"), and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of JACKSON County, Michigan.

**STATEMENT OF VOTES**

The statements of votes polled in the four (4) voting precincts of the District, at a special election held on Monday, January 29, 1996, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered said statements, the whole number of votes given for and against the proposition reading as follows:

I. **BONDING PROPOSITION**

Shall Northwest School District, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Thirty-Four Million Five Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$34,595,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

- erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to the High School, Junior High School and Parnall Elementary School;
- partially remodeling, refurnishing and re-equipping all school buildings;
- acquiring and installing educational technology in school buildings; and
- developing and improving playgrounds, outdoor physical education facilities and sites?

Shall Northwest School District, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Four Million Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$4,085,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of erecting, furnishing and equipping an expanded athletic complex addition to the Northwest High School and developing and improving the site?

Shall Northwest School District, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Four Million Nine Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$4,980,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of erecting, furnishing and equipping a new Performing Arts Center addition to the Northwest High School and developing and improving the site?
