STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the One(1) voting precinct of  
the Springport Township, at the Special Election held on Tuesday,  
October 7, 1997, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk,  
and with this Board. Having examined and considered said  
statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for and  
against the three propositions, reading:

**Shall the 15 mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Springport  
Township imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution be increased  
for said Township by 3.5 mills (\$3.50 per \$1000.00 of taxable value) for a period of 1997  
through 2001 inclusive for police protection: and shall the Township levy such increase in  
millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$80,500.00?**
