Tuesday, September 23, 1997 in Grass Lake Community School District, Jackson and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of Jackson County, Michigan.

STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the One(1) voting precinct of the Grass Lake School District, at the Special Election held on Tuesday, September 23, 1997, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk, and with this Board. Having examined and considered said statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for and against the three propositions, reading:

I. BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Grass Lake Community Schools, Jackson and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Six Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$605,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of :

replacing the roofs and windows at the George Long Elementary School and the Junior/Senior High School? (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond process must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

Shall Grass Lake Community Schools, Jackson and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed One Million Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,065,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

partially remodeling, refurnishing and re-equipping the George Long Elementary School and the Junior/Senior High School?

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond process must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

erecting, furnishing and equipping and addition to the George Long Elementary School; relocating a portion of the playground and developing and improving the site?

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond process must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
