STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the Four (4) voting precinct of the Northwest School District, at the Special Election held on Monday, September 22, 1997, has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk, and with this Board. Having examined and considered said statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for and against the three propositions, reading:

Proposition I.

MILLAGE PROPOSAL, BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX LEVY

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Northwest School District, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000.00) on taxable valuation for a period of 3 years, 1997, 1998, and 1999, to create a sinking fund for the purchases of real estate for sites for, and construction or repair of, school buildings; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the 1997 calendar year is approximately \$322,000?

Bonding Proposal

Shall Northwest School District, Jackson and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Eighteen Million Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$18,070,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to the Northwest High School, Junior High School, Parnall and Flora List Elementaries and the administration/maintenance building;

partially remodeling, refurnishing and re-equipping school buildings;

acquiring and installing educational technology improvements; and

developing and improving outdoor physical education Facilities, play fields and sites?

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
