In Columbia Township, Jackson County, Michigan and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of Jackson County, Michigan.

STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the three (3) voting precinct(s) of the Township, at a special elections held on Tuesday, May 25, 1999, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered said statements, the whole number of votes given for and against the referendum reading as follows:

I. MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR FIRE PROTECTION

Shall the previously voted increase in the 15-mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Columbia Township be renewed at ½ mill (\$.50 on each \$1,000 of State Equalized Valuation) for 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003 inclusive, for fire protection; and shall the township levy such renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$104,712.50.

were as follows:

Total number of votes cast FOUR HUNDRED (400)

Total number of **YES** votes TWO HUNDRED SEVENTEEN (217)

Total number of **NO** votes ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE (183)

THE QUESTION IS DECLARED TO HAVE PASSED.

II. MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR POLICE PROTECTION

Shall the previously voted increase in the 15-mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Columbia Township be renewed at 1 mill (\$1 on each \$1,000 of State Equalized Valuation) for 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003 inclusive, for police protection; and shall the Township levy such renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$209,425.00.

were as follows:

Total number of votes cast THREE HUNDRED NINETY EIGHT (398)

Total number of YES votes ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR (184)

Total number of NO votes TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN (214)
