STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statement of votes cast in the two (2) voting precincts of the COLUMBIA SCHOOL DISTRICT at the Special Election held on Thursday, August 24, 2000 has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk and with this Board. Having examined and considered said statement, this Board has canvassed the votes cast for the Operating Millage Proposal as follows:

OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL NON-HOMESTEAD AND NON-QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL PROPERTY TAX

This millage will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills against non-homestead and non-qualified agricultural property required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation guarantee.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom homestead and qualified agricultural property as defined by law, in Columbia School District, Jackson, Lenawee, Washtenaw and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, be increased by 2 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000.00) on taxable valuation for a period of 5 years, 2000 to 2004, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the calendar year 2000 is approximately \$304,000 (this millage is to restore the "Headlee" reduction)?

Precinct I: One hundred twenty-eight (128).

Precinct II: Ninety-four (94).

Total Two hundred twenty-two (222).

Total number of votes **FOR THE PROPOSITION**

Precinct I: One hundred eleven (111).

Precinct II: Eighty-three (83).

Total: One hundred ninety-four (194).

Total number of votes **AGAINST THE PROPOSITION**

Precinct I: Seventeen (17).

Precinct II: Eleven (11).

Total: Twenty-eight (28).

The question is declared to have Passed.
