## MILLAGE PROPOSAL

### OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL NON-HOMESTEAD AND NON-QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL PROPERTY TAX

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom homestead and qualified agricultural property, as defined by law, in Grass Lake Community Schools, Jackson and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, be increased by two (2) mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of fourteen (14) years, 2000 to 2013, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes?

(The estimate of revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the 2000 calendar year is approximately \$63,230.00).

(Passage of this proposition for authorization of new additional millage will enable the school district to levy not more than the statutory rate of 18 mills on the non-homestead and non-qualified agricultural property, without the reduction otherwise required by the Headlee Amendment.)
