STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statement of votes cast in the one voting precinct of the CONCORD COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT at the Special Election held on Tuesday, September 11, 2001 has been filed with the Jackson County Clerk and with this Board. Having duly examined and considered said statement, this Board has canvassed the votes given for and against the three bonding propositions reading as follows:

I. BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Concord Community Schools, Jackson County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Eight Million One Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$8,145,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping an addition or additions to and partially remodeling, refurbishing and re-equipping the elementary/middle school and high school; acquiring and installing educational technology; improving athletic field lighting; developing and improving sites?

were as follows:

II. BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Concord Community Schools, Jackson County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed One Million Seven Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$1,740,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping multi-purpose and locker rooms as an addition to the elementary/middle school proposed cafeteria; partially remodeling, refurbishing and re-equipping the high school; re-roofing and improving the HVAC and electrical systems of the administration building' developing and improving sites?

were as follows:

TOTAL NUMBER OF VOTES CAST: One thousand sixty seven (1,067)

Total number of YES votes Three hundred sixty two (362)

Total number of NO votes Seven hundred five (705)

III. BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Concord Community Schools, Jackson County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Four Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$4,950,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

adding canopies to the elementary/middle school and partially remodeling, refurbishing and re-equipping the elementary/middle school and high school; acquiring and installing educational technology; constructing improvements to the outdoor athletic facilities; developing and improving sites?

were as follows:

Total number of YES votes Two hundred thirty nine (239)

Total number of NO votes Eight hundred six (806)

Total number of invalid votes Zero (0)




