

Purpose of Amendment

The purpose of this amendment is to address changes to the scope of work and associated fees for the acquisition of property and avigation easements related to the construction of Runway 7/25 at the Jackson County Airport. Subsequent to the approval of the prime contract, executed on April 20, 2009, additional negotiations with the subconsultants providing services related to the land acquisition and land survey resulted in the changes noted below. These revisions have been acknowledged by the Airport Manager, as well as the MDOT Bureau of Aeronautics, per conversations which resulted after the submission of the prime contract.

Scope of Services

This amendment provides for the following services:

- 1) FirstROW, Inc. will replace the JR Group, LLC, as the land consultant responsible for negotiating the acquisition of easements for parcels 97, 98 and 99. They will be responsible for the preliminary interviews, negotiations, and closings, as well as coordination and payment of the real estate appraiser and the review appraiser.
- 2) Ripstra-Scheppelman, Inc. will be required to provide additional land survey effort to identify the specific obstructions on the parcels identified for avigation easements. This includes property boundary survey of those parcels which will have avigation easements. This survey will be used to accurately locate the parcels relative to the runway end.

Compensation

The CONSULTANT shall be compensated a lump sum amount for the change in services. The additional amount of compensation as a result of this amendment shall be Thirty-five thousand seven hundred and 00/100 (\$35,700 dollars).

RESOLUTION (06-09.13) SUPPORTING ADEQUATE STATE FUNDING TO HOLD COUNTIES HARMLESS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES LAWSUIT SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, The State of Michigan, Department of Human Services, was sued by Children's Rights regarding the care of children in foster care; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services settled the case out-of-court without consent or consultation from Michigan's counties; and

WHEREAS, Michigan counties are the funding source for one-half of the costs of foster care and juvenile justice services in the State of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, The cost of the settlement agreement between the Department of Human Services and Children's Rights would require Michigan's counties to pay, without their consent, up to \$32,000,000 per year statewide in *calculable costs*, with additional county costs evident that are not able to be calculated; and

WHEREAS, Michigan's counties face staggering cuts to services across the board due to declining property tax base, state funding cuts to support mandated services, increasing responsibilities eliminated from the state government being forced to counties, and increasing state regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Jackson County Board of Commissioners urges the legislature and the Governor to hold counties harmless from the increased County Child Care Fund expenses associated with the agreement reached between the Department of Human Services and Children's Rights; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution be distributed to Governor Granholm, Senators Richardson and Schauer, Representatives Griffin and Simpson, and the Michigan Association of Counties for their consideration and action.


COUNTY OF JACKSON BUDGET ADJUSTMENT REVENUE 2009

Opt-Out Tax Exempt Resolution Grass Lake Charter Township Proposed Ordinance

Establishing Downtown Development Authority and Downtown District

WHEREAS, Charter Township of Grass Lake desires to establish an Downtown Development Authority (DDA) of the Charter Township of Grass Lake; and,

WHEREAS, Jackson County has reviewed the proposed establishment of the DDA of the Charter Township of Grass Lake; and

WHEREAS, the proposed establishment of the DDA of the Charter Township of Grass Lake may or will prevent the County from levying and collecting ad valorem property taxes or that said taxes will be subject to capture by the Grass Lake Charter Township DDA; and

WHEREAS, the County of Jackson desires to be exempt from capture of said taxes otherwise subject to levy; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County further does not desire to surrender to or to allow the DDA of the Charter Township of Grass Lake to capture the ad valorem tax revenues otherwise payable to the County of Jackson and that said loss could amount to a substantial loss to the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Jackson County does and hereby exempts its current and any future levy of ad valorem property taxes on the land in the proposed establishment of a DDA of the Charter Township of Grass Lake.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Jackson County declines and otherwise opts out of the proposed establishment of a DDA of the Charter Township of Grass Lake but encourages discussions concerning the formulation and execution of an inter-local agreement with Grass Lake Charter Township with respect to the proposed establishment of an DDA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be served upon the Clerk of Grass Lake Charter Township effective June 16, 2009.

Said Resolution was offered at a special meeting of the Jackson County Board of Commissioners held at the Jackson County Tower Building on the 16th day of June 2009.
