- c. PFN update-infrastructure move
 - i. All conversions have been completed on the 911 network. We moved four of the 8 admin lines from Windstream to Comcast and now have the ability to forward those lines, if needed.
 - ii. On January 7th all lines were ringing back over on the old trunk lines, PFN has no answers as to why this happened, they continue to investigate (8 counties in all).

There is a congressional bill (HR 2165) that was introduced early last year that called for the amendment of the Wireless Communications and Public Safety Act of 1999, to clarify acceptable 9–1–1 obligations or expenditures, and for other purposes. Essentially, federal constraints and limitations on what 911 funds can be spent for to eliminate improper diversion of 911 funds.

- k. Ray Baum's act went into effect January 6th. It requires that newer phone systems provide the caller's street address, building number, floor, and exact dispatchable location of the phone they are calling from. This is for Municipal buildings.
